Inclement Weather Procedures

We follow Enfield Public Schools for closings, delays or early dismissals due to inclement weather. If there are changes to our regular school day you will receive a call from Mrs. Mongillo or Ms. Leesa with a detailed message. A notice will also be posted to the school's Facebook page. The town of Enfield does have a closing information line, that number is (860)-253-5170.

Our inclement weather policy is as follows:

If Enfield Public Schools announces any type of delay Little Angels will ONLY have a **90 minute delay** and there will be no CUBS. School will begin at **10:30 AM** for all students. If Enfield Public Schools announces any form of early release Little Angels will be dismissed at **12:00 PM** and there will be no ACES. If Enfield Public Schools closes due to weather then Little Angels will be closed as well.

Sick Policy

Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well. If your child has a fever they must be fever free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours prior to returning to school. They also need to be vomit and diarrhea free for 24 hours in order to return to school. We want to keep everyone and our school healthy this winter.
