Our inclement weather policy is as follows:

If Enfield Public schools announces any type of delay Little Angels will ONLY have a **90 minute delay** and there will be no CUBS. **School starts at 10:30 am.** If there's an early release Little Angels will be dismissed at 12:00p.m. And there will be no ACES. If Enfield Public School closes due to weather than Little Angels will be closed as well.

What's happening in our room this month.

This month we will explore winter, winter animals and hibernation. We will also explore Jan Brett stories. She writes wonderful stories about animals and winter. This month I will be spending the beginning of the month assessing the children to prepare for our parent/teacher Conferences that will be scheduled at the end of the month.

Religion: God Made Light, God Made Color, God Made Weather

Letters: First two weeks we will review A-M. The last two weeks we will learn Nn and Oo

Clifford: Can You Taste the Snow?, Hey There, Little Polar Bear! and A long Winter's Nap.

This month the children will:

- We will read the Mitten. The children will create a mitten and color the animals from the story. So they can retell it.
- We will read The Snowy Nap. Which is a story about our friend 'Hedgie' the hedgehog. Who wants to stay awake this winter. When she is ready to hibernate her friends help her. The children will create a hedgehog and create a place for their hedgehog to hibernate. The children will also retell the animals in this story
- We will read The Hat and the children will create a winter hat. The children will also retell the story with the animals
- We will read Cozy, this story is about a big musk ox, who helps others stay warm in the winter by hiding in his fur. The children will paint a large piece of paper brown to use as Cozy. The children will create those animals and hid them inside their Cozy.
- This month for our name project the children will create a hot chocolate mug with marshmallows that spell out there name!
