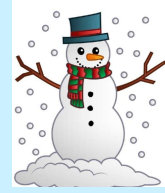

Inclement Weather Procedures

We follow Enfield Public Schools for closings, delays or early dismissals due to inclement weather. If there are changes to our regular school day you will receive a call from Mrs. Mongillo or Leesa Wallburg with a detailed message. A notice will also be posted to the school's Facebook page. The town of Enfield does have a closing information line, that number is (860)-253-5170.

Our inclement weather policy is as follows:

If Enfield Public Schools announces any type of delay Little Angels will ONLY have a 90 minute delay and there will be no before school program. Classes will begin at 10:30 AM for all students. If Enfield Public Schools announces any form of early release Little Angels will be dismissed at 12:00 PM and there will be no after school program. If Enfield Public Schools closes due to weather then Little Angels will be closed as well.
