What we are working on:

This month in our classroom

Each morning we say the Pledge of Allegiance and Our Father prayer. And at snack and lunch we say grace. The children have made so much progress with reciting these! We are working on the hand placement for "In the name of the Father"...we encourage you to practice at home with them

Letters we are working on:

Week of 10/28: "U" another vowel (2 sounds)! "U says U and u, u, u". The children might hold up their hand like they are holding an **U**mbrella and lift it **U**p.

Week of 11/4: "C"

Week of 11/11: "O"

Week of 11/18: "Q"

Week of 11/25: short week (Thanksgiving) so we will review and talk about vowels some more as part of the review.

We finished up our 5 senses this week and will start to talk about "caring and sharing" and managing emotions.

For religion we are going to be discussing how we can **care, share, and be helpful.**

In November, we will be changing the centers. We are still working on having the children stay engaged in the centers they choose. I have seen great progress so far, and we will continue to encourage them... even with the anticipated excitement about the new items in the centers.

The children have been doing an **AMAZING** job with lining up and **staying** in line. We are working hard at **not** passing the person in front of us. This is harder than it sounds for a 3 year old!
