January 2-3

Religion: I Can Celebrate Letter: Review A-M

This week we will be starting a two week review on our letters from the first half of the year, A-M. We will literally wrap up the season of Christmas by wrapping gifts for baby Jesus and delivering them to the church manger on 3 King's Day.

January 6-10

Inclement Weather Policy

We follow Enfield Public Schools for closings, delays or early dismissals due inclement weather. If there are changes to our regular school day you will receive a phone call with a detailed message. Our inclement weather policy is as follows:
