Inclement Weather Policy

We follow Enfield Public Schools for closings, delays or early dismissals due to inclement weather. If there are changes to our regular school day you will receive a phone call with a detailed message. A notice will also be posted to the school's Facebook page. Our inclement weather policy is as follows:

If Enfield Public schools announces any type of delay Little Angels will ONLY have a **90 minute delay** and there will be no CUBS. **School starts at 10:30 am**. If there's an early release Little Angels will be dismissed at 12:00p.m. And there will be no ACES. If Enfield Public School closes due to weather than Little Angels will be closed as well.
